
Morning Program

7:00 - 9:00 AM



Our before school program offers early morning fun and a variety of activity choices for elementary children to enjoy. These activities include quiet reading, homework assistance, team and active games, contests and challenges, arts & crafts, and gamesroom activities. A nutritious breakfast is served from 7:30 to 8:00 AM daily. After a fulfilling morning of fun with friends, children are accompanied by a staff member to their bus stop, or driven to school in a Club van.

Afternoon Program

3:00 - 6:30 PM



This group oriented program brings children together by grade with trained counselors for fun-filled afternoons of diverse activities. Together they participate in age appropriate activities and occasional field trips. Staff present activity options during a daily group time and children are empowered to choose how they want to spend their time. Children will be given opportunities to cook, create arts & crafts projects, participate in small & large group games, use computers, and work on homework.

Transportation

School bus or van transportation to and from the Club is provided for Adams, Loyal Heights, North Beach, St. Al's, West Woodland, and Whittier. Service to other schools can be arranged through the school district transportation department. Parents are responsible for arranging school bus transportation before the first day of school.
